Bursary Guidance Notes

Through the generosity of The Shanly Foundation, we are able to offer a limited number of bursaries to assist children in financial need to access Sayers Croft.

Requests for bursaries have increased considerably. In order for us to assess the number we can allocate to each school, please provide as much detail as possible to justify individual applications. Please be reassured we treat sensitive data with the utmost confidence and due process. Full names are not required.

We are unable to accept pupil premium/free school meals as sole cause; bursaries are intended for children in extremely challenging financial circumstances who would not be able to attend Sayers Croft without this additional support.

We may not be able to provide all the bursaries requested.

Bursaries are allocated on a case by case basis, and are non transferable to other children without the written prior agreement of Sayers Croft. In the event that the bursary recipient does not attend Sayers Croft, the bursary will not be awarded.

Bursaries are only released after a letter of gratitude is sent to the Shanly Foundation. The letter can come from the bursary recipient, class teacher, head teacher, or parent/guardian. Instructions will be given when the bursary is confirmed by Sayers Croft.
