Competition Format	Please check www.sportshall.org for the exact format of the competition – there are slight differences for the year 3/4 and year 5/6 competition, please look out for these. Declaration sheets will be emailed to schools along with the link to online entry.		
Team Information	<p>School teams should consist of a minimum of 9 girls and 9 boys, with a maximum of 15 girls and 15 boys being permitted from the combined year groups. They may compete in a maximum of two track and two field events.</p> <p>Each school will be expected to submit a declaration sheet at the beginning of the competition. Please make sure that you have two copies of the declaration sheet, one for submission and one for your reference during the competition.</p> <p>The number of spaces on the declaration sheet corresponds with the number of children needed for each event. There should be no empty spaces once you have completed your form.</p>		

Follow-On Opportunities	<p>The top two teams at the year 5/6 competitions will be invited to a finals afternoon which will be used to determine the final winner who will go on to represent Westminster at the Level 3 School Games competition in the Spring. There will a Central London qualifier and then if the team is successful at the qualification stage, they will be invited to Crystal Palace to compete in the finals.</p> <p>There is no competitive follow-on opportunity for year 3 and 4.</p>
PE Kits	All participants should be wearing PE kit, preferably shorts and a t-shirt. It is really important that schools wear kit so that they can be easily identified by time keepers. All competitors should be wearing footwear appropriate for a sports hall.
Equipment	All equipment is provided by WSU.
First Aid	Schools should provide their own first aid. Whilst there will be qualified first aiders on site, this is not their primary function and first aid can be administered more swiftly if schools bring their own kits.
Photography	A photographer may be in attendance, please make sure that all your team members have photographic consent. If you have a child that is not able to be photographed please let the WSU team know on arrival.
