PESS Membership Package

PESS membership gives you access to the following services:

Competitions

The competitions and festivals are for pupils in years 1-6; and they are delivered throughout the academic year by the PALS team and our ActiveWestminster accredited partners.

Sport Leaders UK

This program is designed to increase the confidence, communication and organization skills of pupils in years 5 & 6.

Your school will be given a one-year license to the program, which will give you resources to develop your young leaders to become a helpful PE and School Sport workforce.

Network Meetings & CPD Sessions

There are three half-day meetings that take place once a term and includes updates from our partners, competition reviews, CPD sessions and opportunities to network with other schools and leisure providers.

A Review Day takes place in June and includes an evaluation of the year's activities and planning for the next academic year.

PE Safety Membership

Dedicated School Games Organiser

Our School Games Organiser can help answer your PE and School Sport enquiries and questions. Our strong relationships with local, regional and national partners mean that if we cannot answer your questions we will find the right person who can.

PE Advisor, Jan Hickman, is able to provide a bespoke PE CPD session, tailored to the needs of your school. Sessions can consist of any of the following:

- Up-skilling class teachers in gymnastics and dance
- PE Premium accountability measures
- Safe practice and risk assessment
- Preparing PE subject leaders for Ofsted
- Reviewing policy documentation
- Curriculum mapping and equipment recommendations.

Your school will receive a report on the areas discussed which you can use as evidence of effective and appropriate use of the PE and Sport premium funding. School Games Mark

Our Schools Games Organiser will support you to achieve the School Games Mark, which is a Government led awards scheme designed to recognise and reward schools for their commitment to the development of PE, School Sport and Competition.

Support includes spending time with your PE coordinator to understand which criteria your school currently meets (bronze, silver or gold) and to help develop a plan to support schools in reaching the next level.

ActiveWestminster Partnership Benefits

Alongside these listed services, the ActiveWestminster Partnership will bring members additional benefits and programmes of activity to schools.

Gifted and Talented

Selected pupils in years 5 and 6 can be referred to the Gifted and Talented training sessions at Little Venice Sports Centre. The training is free of charge and is designed to improve technique and knowledge from an athletics foundation incorporating numerous aspects of motor skills development.

Club Links

Our partnership with Middlesex Cricket Club (MCC) and Lords gives all Westminster schools an exciting package, which includes cricket provision, training and match tickets all for no cost. Our dedicated Relationship Officer – Sport (Ian Bannister) can support schools to create links with local sport clubs and organisations that have been awarded the ActiveWestminster accreditation Mark for achieving a set of minimum standards.

We are offering the PESS Membership at a subsidized rate of £590 meaning schools only need to allocate a small amount of their Primary PE and Sport premium to become a member.

Our Programmes and Partners



ActiveWestminster, formally the Westminster Sports Unit, has been around for 31 years providing leisure, physical activity and sport opportunities for schools, children, young people and adults across the City of Westminster.

Our leisure contractor, Everyone Active, manage daily operations of our leisure centres and work closely with us in order to deliver our ActiveWestminster Card offering for schools and residents.

As part of the ActiveWestminster partnership you have access to a network of around 300 professional sports clubs as well as voluntary and private community-based stakeholders working together to improve opportunities available to people who live, work and study in the City of Westminster.

The ActiveWestminster Mark is a two-year minimum standards accreditation mark which shows Westminster residents that independent coaches, clubs or organisations meet a range of minimum standards set by the ActiveWestminster partnership, including health and safety, safeguarding, appropriate coaching qualifications and insurance.



London Sport is our regional County sport and physical activity body funded by Sport England. They have a dedicated PE and School Sport team responsible for working closely with local authorities and sport units to support schools to utilise the Primary PE premium funding.



The Tri-borough Healthy Schools Partnership was launched in 2012, with the aim to support schools to focus on health and wellbeing. We are working closely with the Healthy Schools Team to ensure our programmes are aligned and offer added value to schools. Schools can apply for the Healthy Schools Partnership's bronze, silver and gold awards.





The Youth Sport Trust is a charity which focuses on quality PE and School Sport. Their mission is to change young people's lives through sport. They are commissioned by Sport England to be the strategic agent for the School Games, offering support and advise to the Levels 1-3 delivery partners



London Youth Games (LYG) is the largest youth sports festival within Europe. It takes place over 9 months and includes school and community competitions across 30 different sports. London Youth Games also organise the School Games Finals.



Established by a former Primary schools head teacher, the Daily Mile removes barriers to physical activity for teachers and pupils. Pupils can run, jog or walk a set route around the school for 15 minutes every day.
